

The German Unit (Hannover) of the International Network of the UNESCO Chair in Bioethics (Haifa), represented by its Head, Professor Gerhard Fortwengel


sign this Memorandum of Understanding with the purpose of:

This Memorandum will be in effect for two years henceforth; it may be reviewed and amended by mutual written consent. It may also be extended by mutual agreement.


